Applications are invited for filling up the post of Director on deputation basis in the following Institutes of Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE) in pay scales indicated against the post with allowances as admissible under rules in ICFRE:-

The eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions for the above said posts are stated below:-

**Director, IFGTB, Coimbatore and Director, RFRI, Jorhat**

**A. For Members of Indian Forest Service:**

**A.1 Essential Qualifications:**

A serving member of Indian Forest Service having completed 26 years of service with reference to year of allotment, who has at least 5 years research experience on posts in Forestry Research. The time spent in obtaining Ph.D. degree shall not be counted towards this minimum required research experience, unless the officer has held charge of regular post in Forestry Research concurrently.

**A.2 Desirable Qualifications:**

1. Doctoral Degree.

**B. For Scientists:**


**B.1 Essential Qualifications:**

A candidate having First Class Masters Degree in Basic Sciences/Agriculture & Allied Sciences/Forestry & Allied Sciences and other related disciplines from a recognized University, with 26 years of service with reference to the date of appointment as Group 'A' Scientists and who has 15 years experience in Forestry Research. The time spent in obtaining Ph.D. degree shall not be counted towards this minimum required research experience, unless the Scientist has held charge of a regular post in Forestry Research concurrently.

**B.2 Desirable Qualifications:**

1. Doctoral Degree.

**Head Quarters:-** The Head quarter(s) of the of Director, IFGTB shall be Coimbatore, and for Director, RFRI shall be Jorhat.



The Director General, ICFRE, with the approval of the MoEF can transfer incumbent working on the post of DDG/Director in the Council to another post of DDG/Director as per requirement and the officers appointed to these posts shall be liable to serve anywhere in India.

**Age:-**Not exceeding 57 years as on 30.06.2014.

**Eligibility:-**The crucial date for determining eligibility criteria shall be 30.06.2014

**Tenure:-** The tenure of deputation shall ordinarily be five years or till superannuation, whichever is earlier, and as per guidelines of the Government of India.

**“Cooling off” requirement:-** “Cooling off”, period for the posts shall be as per guidelines of the Government of India.

**Debarment:-** In case an officer, to whom offer of appointment to any of the above posts does not report either on his own volition or at the instance of the Cadre authority, he would be debarred from consideration for a post in ICFRE for a period of 5 years.

### General Instructions:

1. Applications with complete bio-data together with a fee of ₹ 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **the Drawing and Disbursing Officer (DDO), ICFRE** should reach the office of the Secretary, Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education, P.O. New Forest, Dehradun on or before 30.06.2014.
2. The closing date of receipt of applications from candidates residing in Andaman & Nicobar Island and Lakshdweep will be 15.07.2014.
3. Separate application should be submitted alongwith Demand Draft of Rs.100/- for each post if a candidate wishes to apply for more than one post.
4. Application and the envelope should be superscripted as “Application for the post of \_\_\_\_\_” against Advt.No.1/Directors/2014-ICFRE”. Applications incomplete in any respect shall be summarily rejected.
5. In no case the Council will be responsible for non-receipt of applications or any delay in receipt thereof on any account whatsoever. No application received after the stipulated last date will be entertained under any circumstances and all the late applications will be summarily rejected.
6. The candidate must submit their application through proper channel. The concerned department/organization should enclose vigilance clearance report and Annual Confidential Reports of the officer for the last seven years for the years **2007-2008 to 2013-2014** while forwarding the applications of the candidates. However, an advance copy can be submitted alongwith the prescribed fee.
7. The IFS officers who have not completed the mandatory “Cooling off” period, as the case may be, in his/her parent cadre between two spells of deputation as on 30.06.2014 will not be considered for the post.
8. The Council reserves the right to relax, the qualifications/experience in case of exceptionally qualified and meritorious candidates.
9. The Council reserves the right not to fill up the vacancies advertised if the circumstances so warrant in the interest of the Council.
