# Significant Research Findings

#### Institute of Forest Genetic and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- Molecular docking studies of the phytocompounds identified in the bark samples of Pterocarpus santalinus Linn. through chromatographic analysis having anti-inflammatory activity against the targeted ligand protein were performed and found that Lup-20(29)-en-3-ol, (3.beta.)-(CAS) (Lupeol) was the most potential compound having highest docking score of -8.47 against the protein NR3C1(1NHZ) indicate that Lupeol constitute promising lead compound as chemother apy agents for anti-inflammatory activity.
- Identified and documented a very large tree of Terminalia arjuna during population survey for FGRs at Jawathu Hills (Melpattu forest area; N12°25'46.89", E078°51'06", Altitude: 929 msl) in Tiruvannamalai forest division of Tamil Nadu in the month of February 2022. Its height was 18.5 m and Girth at breast height

was 1347 cm, with a clear bole height of 4m. This tree has been found to be the largest among the T. arjuna trees documented by IFGTB and therefore recommends the conservation of this particular tree as a valuable genetic resource for posterity, similar to that of Kannimara teak at Topslip.

#### Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- Database was updated to 248 species of moths belonging to 10 families with information on date of record, GPS coordinates, altitude, number of individuals, classification, name and image of each of the species sampled for 2 year data.
- From Pathankot Reserve Forest Division, Punjab, 22 Forest • Genetic Resource (FGR) species were documented and Page regeneration data were recorded.

- Extraction parameters for isolation of natural fibre from *Pueraria lobata* (an invasive weed) were optimised.
- Dyeing and mordanting trials on different fabrics were conducted with the natural dye derived from *Punica granatum* peels under pre-post and simultaneous mordanting condition.
- Synthesis of Titanium oxide NPs (TiO-NPs) was carried out by using 25% aqueous methanol extracts of sawdust of *Shorea Robusta*, *Dalbergia sissoo* and knotwoods of *Mangifera indica*, *Melia dubia*, *Toona ciliata*, *Acacia nilotica*, *Azadirachta indica*, *Eucalyptus tereticornis*, *E. citriodora* and *E. hybrid*.

#### **Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat**

Prepared a Digital Versatile Disc (DVD) on Artificial Pollination of Orchids. The DVD contains step-wise instructions for artificial pollination in rare and endangered orchids.

#### Institute of Forest Productivity, Ranchi

- 14 new Candidate Plus Trees (CPTs) of Mahua and 39 new CPTs of Neem have been selected from West Bengal.
- Demonstration plot cum field trials of *Poplar* and *Melia dubia* have been established in Araria, Begusarai and Gaya districts of Bihar.
- Poplar and Melia based Agroforestry models have been established to demonstrate the model to the farmers in Bihar.
