Significant Research Findings

Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- DNA extraction from leaves of *Populus gamblei* was achieved and It was observed that the extraction buffer having CTAB + β-mercaptoethanol (1µL) + PVP (2%) gave the best results in extraction of DNA in *P. gamblei* as it yielded pure and high quality DNA suitable for further molecular analysis.
- Acute toxicity of the extract isolated from the peels of *Punica* granatum using 25% aqueous methanol was examined on Swiss albino mice using OECD 423 guidelines and the extract was found to be non toxic below 2000 mg /Kg of body weight of the animal and suitable for conducting *in vivo* biological studies.

Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru

Standardized the ERT equipment for sandalwood by developing a linear regression model using actual and ERT heartwood data. Achieved a similarity of 90% with $R^2 = 0.95$. Plotted the graph of ERT heartwood data and resistance pattern for 32 plantations.

Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- In vitro evaluation of antimicrobial, antioxidant, antiinflammatory and anti-arthritic activity of the methanol extract of the medicinal plants viz. Wrightia tinctoria (leaf), Cissus quadrangularis (stem) and Cinchona officinalis (bark) plant samples revealed that the bark methanol extract of C.officinalis was more promising and the active ingredients present in its bark cited for the anti-arthritic activity. Hence, the bark extract of C.officinalis can be used in the development of therapeutic product
- Identified 16 high fruit yielding CPTs of Aegle marmelos from districts of Ramanathapuram, Dindugal, Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Sivagangai, collected fruits, proposed and

conducted germination studies. Recorded tree passport data & documented variations in fruit/seed parameters.

Institute of Forest Productivity, Ranchi

- Developed first time ETP plantation technique of *Melia dubia*. It will protect Melia plantation from grazing and other biotic pressure.
- Isolated genomic DNA of *Buchnania cochinchinensis*, *Gmelina arborea*, *D. latifolia* and *Shorea robusta* for molecular characterization and genetic diversity study.

Consultancies

Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education, Dehradun

Works on the fifteen different ongoing scientific consultancy projects were carried out during the period. Field data collection for works to Biodiversity related studies wrt Chakla coal mine in Latehar, Jharkhand and EA-EPIR of CIL Mines of Lajkura and Belpahar OCP mines of MCL, Odisha respectively.

New proposals Submitted

- Environmental Audit of Kusmunda open cast coal mine was submitted to South Eastern Coalfield Limited (SECL), Kusmunda Area, Korba, Chhattisgarh.
- A bid document for "Estimation of Standing Biomass in eight units of NLCIL (Mine-MI, Mine-MIA, Mine-MII, Thermal units of TPS-IE, TPS-II, TPS-IIE, NNTPS, TA in and around peripheral areas) approximately in an area of 20,000 hectares for 3 seasons and assess the measures to achieve carbon Neutrality was submitted to NLCIL, Neyveli, Cuddalore (Dt), Tamil Nadu".
