Significant Research Findings

Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

 Collected fruit samples of *Pyrus pashia* and *Ficus almate* from Tehri, Chakrata and Mussoorie Forest Division of Uttarakhand. Morphological data such as fruit weight and fruit dia, moisture %, and TSS (total soluble solid) values were determined. Two different value added products 'wild anjeer jam' and 'wild anjeer candy' from *Ficus palmate* fruits were prepared and stored.

 A comparison of *in vitro* callogenesis in 11 different clones of *Populus deltoides* was done, variation in in-itro callus formation was observed in among clones, DNA extraction from leaves of *P. gamblei* was achieved and it was observed



that the extraction buffer having CTAB + β -mercaptoethanol (1 μ L) + PVP (2%) gave the best results in extraction of DNA in *P. gamblei* as it yielded pure and high quality DNA suitable for further molecular analysis.

 Marker compound Arjungenin assisted chemical screening of the extracts isolated from the bark of two populations of *Terminalia arjuna* located in Dehradun, Uttarakhand (02 accessions) and Farinda, U.P. (20 accessions) using HPLC was carried out. Arjungenin content in the population of Farinda was 1.06% while Dehradun population was not found to contain arjungenin.

Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- Molecular docking studies of the phyto compounds identified in the heartwood samples of *Pterocarpus santalinus* Linn. against the targeted ligand protein indicated the isolated compound with highest docking score for anti -microbial activity is suitable for the development of skin care products.
- CRISPR/Cas9 edited Eucalyptus plantlet generated by Agrobacterium tumefaciens mediated transformation were analyzed by amplicon sequencing to show the desired deletion in the target gene sequence of EcHKT1;1. Gene editing constructs developed had been earlier tested for generating desired deletion using the composite transgenic approach.

Institute of Forest Productivity, Ranchi

Automatic weather station (AWS) has been installed in Bundu Range office Khunti Division Jharkhand to record day to day meteorological data.
