Significant Research Findings

Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- LC-QTOF-MS analysis of 25% aqueous methanolic extracts of Prinsepia utilis leaves collected from Tarela (Himachal Pradesh.) and Munsyari (Uttarakhand) was carried out and eleven flavonoids namely rutin, nicotiflorin, kaempferol-3gentiobioside-7-rhamnoside, clitorin, quercetin 3-0-β-Dglucoside, vicenin-3, keioside, querecetin-3-0-sophoroside, manghaslin, querecetin 3-sambubioside, and isorhamnetin 3- $0-[\beta-D-glucopyranosyl-(1->2)-[\alpha-L-rhamnopyranosyl-$ (1->6)]-β-D-glucopyranoside] in these extracts were identified.
- Extraction and estimation of seed oil from total eight neem seed samples was carried out by using soxhlet method. The % yield of seed oil from eight samples was estimated as 24.03%, 25.30%, 26%, 26.30%, 24%, 26%, 25.74% and 27.21%.

Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- The efficacy of the biopesticide, Tree PAL^H, Simarouba glauca and Neem oil as positive controls were tested against *Ailanthus* excelsa defoliator, Eligma narcissus under laboratory, nursery hours after treatment respectively. and field conditions and observed 96-100%, 61.42-66.67% and 65 - 72% larval mortality respectively at 5000 ppm @ 48 hours of observation.
- Under the IFGTB-ISHA Collaborative Research Project on 'Monitoring of soil organic carbon in agroforestry, natural and conventional farming systems in Tamil Nadu', the overall soil organic carbon content ranged between 0.06% and 1.57% with a mean value of 0.67%. The lowest SOC content (0.06%) was recorded in Krishnagiri district and the highest SOC (1.57%) was recorded in Tiruvarur district under agroforestry systems. Out of the 414 agroforestry samples, 22.95% of the samples were low, 38.65% medium and 38.41% were high in organic carbon content. Adoption of agroforestry practices resulted in higher total mean soil organic carbon content than non-agroforestry practices.

Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru

A total of 74 Dendrocalamus stocksii accessions were evaluated using multi-trait analysis method. Out of 74

- accessions, 10 best performing accessions were identified for further multiplication. Rhizomes of 9 CPCs of *D. stocksii* were collected from Dapoli accessions for infusing of D.sctoksii germplasm established at Gottipura. Further, rhizomes of 4 CPCs of D.stocksii were collected from Sindudurg area, Maharashtra for further development. About 600 clonal seedlings of Guadua angustifolia and D.sctoksii were produced.
- Aseptic in vitro cultures were established from nodal segments, and shoot initiation was achieved for 9 bamboo species. The procedure for DNA isolation from leaf samples of B. tulda and D. brandisii was optimised for genetic fidelity testing. In vitro rooting of multiplied shoots of pre-existingcultures of 5 species, primary hardening for 4 species and secondary hardening for 6 species were performed.

Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat

Laboratory experiments were conducted to test the effect of biopesticides and chemical pesticides against target pests at laboratory conditions, results revealed that Dichlorovas 76% (0.076%), Profenophos 50EC (0.00712%) Monocrotophos 36 and Pongamia pinnata seed oils at different concentrations EC(0.06%) was found effective with maximum mortality of 96.6, ranging from 0.25% to 1% in comparison with Chlorophyriphos 94.4 and 92.2 respectively. In leaf dip method Profenophos 50 EC (0.00712%) recorded 58.88 and 84.44 mortality of grubs 2 and 48
