### Significant Research Findings

- fatty acid content, ester value, unsaponifiable matter, Hehner value and acetyl value of the fatty oil isolated from Prinsepia utilis seeds collected from Kanasar, Dehradun (Uttarakhand) were determined and found to be 57.21, 7.89, 118.95, 0.4%, 95.47 and 35.5 respectively. These properties are important for quality control of the oil. (FRI, Dehradun)
- Under the project All India Coordinated Research Project on Bamboo - various taxonomic characteristics of 3. Dendrocalamus somdevai were studied and recorded for future study. Herbarium specimens of Bambusa nutans flowering were prepared. Flowering reports of 15 bamboo species from different parts of country were incorporated in the flowering database. (FRI, Dehradun)
- Chromatographic characterization of Wrightia tinctoria through GC/MS/MS analysis revealed the presence of phytocompounds with significant anti-inflammatory, antiallergic and antinociceptive activities, these pytocompounds can be used for therapeutic application. (IFGTB, Coimbatore)
