#### ICFRE- Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru

- The nucleotide sequences of standard barcode regions of mangrove species (21 *Avicennia marina* sequences and 13 *A. officinalis* sequences) were published online in the Nucleotide database of NCBI with accession numbers
- The procedure for DNA extraction from leaf was standardised for 3 species, *Barringtonia racemosa*, *Lagerstroemia microcarpa*, *Dillenia indica*, prioritised for molecular characterisation.
