On -site Training, Demonstration and Motivation programme for cultivation of medicinal plants under traditional orchards Place: Jankipur, Koshambi distt.

In India about 80 per cent land belongs to non forestry area. In Uttar Pradesh only 5.86 % forest are present which includes various type of agroclimatic zones, namely Tarai region bordering Nepal, Western Gangetic plains, Eastern Gangetic plains and Vindhyan, Bundelkhand Plateau and Ravines of various Rivers. Different agro- climatic zones having different types of soils offer different ecological conditions for various tree orchards. Traditionally local people are growing Mahua, Amm, Anola and bamboo in their field and home and it is also observed that these orchards are maintained/multiplied/managed due to lack of transmission of technologies to the user groups. Agroforestry can play a major role in bringing the desired level of diversification along with sustainability and conservation of these orchards. In Eastern Uttar Pradesh there are traditionally growing number of tree species for economic return. The prominent species are Mahua, Amm, Anola, Bamboo and Eucalyptus. The orchards/plantations both ecological and economic benefits are obtained from this kind of system. But since last decade the tree crop are not giving much output and felling of such orchard are being practiced in this area. Agroforestry systems are both stable and sustainable, only recently has it been accepted as science. The use of some shade loving medicinal plant can boom the economy on one hand and conserve these orchards on other hand. Prospects and Problems of these future medicinal plant based agroforestry crops and entrepreneurship have also been discussed during the programme and Training on various aspects of developed technologies of the medicinal plants based agroforestry under tradirtional orchards were transferred to the different user groups and by various means of extension. The technologies is provided to the volinters and progressive farmers/SHGs /NGOs in local languages.

Training programme

Seeds and planting material was distributed among selected farmers who were willing to undertake medicinal plant based agroforestry under traditional orchards.
