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Concise Details of the Event:

Forest Research Centre for Bamboo & Rattan (FRC-BR), Bethlehem Vengthlang, Aizawl, Mizoram (A unit of RFRI Jorhat, Assam) had organized a three days training programme on Value addition of Bamboo shoot at FRCBR Aizawl Mizoram during 27th to 29th October, 2022 funded by ICFRE under CAMPA Extension. The target group of this training were mainly women from the self help group from Sihphir village and MHIP and self help group from village Bethlehem, District Aizawl Mizoram. It was followed by the hands on training on preparation of fermented bamboo shoot pickle and fresh bamboo shoot pickle by Mr Lalrinmawia and Dr C. Lalmuanpuia.
Day 2	At the outset of the day 2, Head FRCBR and nodal officer VVK welcomed the participants and falicitated the resource person Mrs Lalremruati, Nutritionist and Nutritional Consultant Education Deptt, Aizawl and she delivered the presentation on bamboo shoot, its nutritional value and processing. Later she imparted the hands on training on bamboo shoot processing & product development viz., bamboo shoot pickle and bamboo shoot candy, Bamboo shoot Murabba and Bamboo Kimchi.
Day 3	In the beginning of the third and last day, Head FRCBR and Nodal officer VVK, Mizoram Dr. Hans Raj welcomed the participants and felicitated the resource person Mrs Lalremruati, Nutritionist and Nutritional Consultant Education Deptt, Aizawl.
