

TRAINING ON PROPAGATION, NURSERY PRACTICES AND COMMERCIAL CULTIVATION OF BAMBOO

Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat (Assam) in association with Assam Bio-Refinery Pvt. Limited, Numaligarh, Golaghat (Assam) conducted a day-long Skill Development Training on Propagation, Nursery Practices and Commercial Cultivation of Bamboo under Van Vigyan Kendra, Assam at Conference Hall, Duffaloo Guest House, ABRPL, Numaligarh, Golaghat (Assam) on 11 March, 2020. There were altogether 46 participants coming from various places of Assam.

The training programme was inaugurated by Shri G. N. Sarma, CEO, ABRPL. He spoke in details about the Assam Bio Refinery Pvt. Limited. He sensitized the participants to cultivate bamboo in large scale so that they may supply bamboo continuously to the industry once it is operational. He told that ABRPL would require around 5.00 lakh ton of raw bamboo per year. This industry will provide great opportunity to the farmers of Assam near future.

Shri R. K. Kalita delivered a detailed presentation on various aspects of bamboo - its importance, distribution, utilization, diversity, propagation methods, nursery practices, cultivation, harvesting, intercropping etc.

Shri Debojit Neog, Technical Assistant demonstrated practical aspects of bamboo propagation techniques and practical techniques.

The Training programme ended with distribution of Certificates to the participants.
