## Patron's Column



The Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun, a leading organization in forestry sector, is actively engaged in forestry research, education and extension. The Council has a rich tradition of promoting silvicultural practices through hosting pan Indian Silviculture Conferences since 1918. Continuing the legacy, FRI, Dehradun organized the 13<sup>th</sup> Silviculture Conference in November 2014. This 5 day event centering on the theme of multiple values of forests, was attended by over 400 participants from all over the country. I am also glad to inform that IWST, Bengaluru is celebrating golden jubilee of its establishment and, as a part of the yearlong celebrations, it conducted an International Conference “Wood is Good: Current Trends and Future Prospects in Wood Utilization” at Bengaluru.

The Council is known for development of innovative technologies, processes and products. In keeping with this, IFGTB, Coimbatore developed and released a bio-pesticide :Ento~fight Nasa- a mineral oil based preformulated endophytic fungal (*Nigrospora sphaerica*) insecticide for teak, Ailanthus defoliators and other insect pests of important forestry species. Similarly, a bio-control agent ‘Tricho - K’ was formulated and released by the Institute for use by farmers.

ICFRE is also striving to upgrade infrastructure for research and extension. IFGTB, Coimbatore has recently established a geomatics lab with GIS and Remote Sensing facilities at the Institute. Further, two more research stations have been established by it at Thuvarankurichi Research Station in Trichy Forest Division and Manakarai Research Station in Tirunelveli Forest Division. Out of these, the Manakarai Research Station in Tirunelveli is supposed to contribute towards the promotion of dry land agro-forestry with special emphasis on silvi-pasture. Besides, CFLE, Agartala, a centre under RFRI, Jorhat has strengthened its infrastructure by establishment of two Bamboo Treatment Centres in Tripura.

In another significant achievement wherein ICFRE has been entrusted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court for developing R&R Plans for various categories of mines in Bellary, Chitradurga and Tumkur districts of Karnataka, eight more Plans have been prepared and submitted to CEC of the Hon'ble Supreme Court during the last six months. Apart from this, FRI, Dehradun has initiated ecological restorations of degraded mine spoils in two sites Northern Coalfield Limited (NCL), in Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.

I earnestly hope that this issue of the Newsletter will be successful in giving you a glimpse of the diverse activities being conducted at the Council.

DoE conducted Public consultation meetings on 8 and 9 December 2014 at Reckong Peo and Poo in district Kinnaur, H.P. The meeting was attended by the various stakeholders.
- Environmental Impact Assessment and Environmental Management Plan Study Report for 48 MW Surgani Sundla hydro-electric project in Chamba district was submitted to Himachal Pradesh Power Corporation (HPPCL). Public hearing meeting was held on 28 December 2014 at Surgani, Chamba, H.P.
- Draft Report of Environmental Impact Assessment and Environmental Management Plan of the 460 MW Nakthan Hydro Electric Project was submitted to HPPCL. Further, Environmental Public Hearing meeting was

conducted at Barshaini, Kullu, H.P. on 20 September 2014. The report is in the process of revision in light of observations by HPPCL and HPSPCB.

- **FRI, Dehradun** initiated ecological restoration of degraded mine spoils in two sites of 5 ha each in Northern Coalfield Limited (NCL), one at Nighai in Singrauli district of Madhya Pradesh and, other at Krishanshila in Sonbadhra district of Uttar Pradesh. Saplings of forestry, horticulture and medicinal plants were planted and after a period of three months the results quite promising.

- **TFRI, Jabalpur** prepared final report of the consultancy project titled "Preparation of conservation plan and comprehensive studies of

impact on the wildlife for Rajgamar underground project, SECL Korba, C.G" and submitted to the funding agency SECL Korba.

## RESEARCH FINDINGS

- At FRI, Dehradun bamboo culm sheath was pulped, beaten in a valley beater and handmade sheets were prepared from this underutilized biomass. Pulping of the culm sheath material was performed in alkaline condition. The strength properties of the prepared sheets met the required standards.

- A bio-control agent 'Tricho - K' was released by IFGTB, Coimbatore for farmers' use. This bio control agent consists of an antagonistic fungus *Trichoderma viride* and a Potassium solubilising bacteria *Fratueria aurantia*. *T. viride* was found more effective to control the

soil borne diseases such as root rot and stem wilt caused by *Fusarium oxysporum* and *F. solani*. *T. viride* not only kills the pathogens in soil but also protects the plants/trees from the soil pathogens.

- A Biopesticide – Ento Fight Nasa - based on endophytic fungus isolated from teak leaves has been formulated which is effective against defoliators of *Tectona grandis* and *Ailanthus excelsa*.

- Established a provenance trial of *Casuarina equisetifolia* at Neyveli.
- Two species provenance trials of 15 *Eucalyptus mallee* species have been established at Neyveli and Thuvrankurichi field stations. This is the first time line species are subjected to field testing in India.


